BUSINESS MANAGER'S COMMENTS

An unseasonably warm winter has allowed many construction projects to continue and even new projects to break ground. The long awaited Gordie Howe Bridge Project is just around the corner but with it comes the usual cast of characters who would like to steal our work. We are working diligently with municipal, provincial and federal levels of government to adopt language and reassurance that the proper trades will perform the work that falls within their scope of practice.

We have been fortunate to open up communication with the Ford government and Minister of Labour Monte McNaughton, and most recently Mr. Ford has assured us that the new Mega Acute Care facility, coined the Mega Hospital will happen. Major roadway construction is taking place along county road 42 between Lauzon Parkway and Manning road. The road is being converted to five lanes, with roundabouts at the major intersections. This roadway construction is in anticipation of the increased volume of traffic on an already congested road.

In addition to the major industrial and commercial jobs, the area is seeing an increase in condo and large scale commercial developments. I've reached out to the Construction Council of Ontario and the Electrical Contractors Association of Ontario to invite any and all contractors that are signatory to the IBEW to come to our area and bid this work. There are multiple jobs of considerable size that are going unbid, and we will take all the necessary steps required to entice contractors from other areas to go after this work.

Of special note: We have been working with a developer for a few months in designing a new interactive website and it is very close to launch. Please be patient while we work out a few bugs to insure secure access and usage for each eligible member.
